**REGULATION No. 504
STUDENTS**

IMMUNIZATION

It is the policy of the Carson City School District, except as otherwise provided by law, that students enrolled in the District shall be immunized against contagious and infectious diseases. Each student entering the District must present a certificate stating that the student has been immunized and has received proper boosters for immunization for the diseases specified in NRS 392.435 and any additional requirements imposed pursuant to NRS 439.443.

The Certificate of Immunization must be signed by a physician, registered nurse, or medical designee indicating the dates of each immunization and booster(s) received. All immunizations must be up to date.

The Certificate of Immunization shall be included in the pupil's academic or cumulative record and transferred as part of that record on request.

A conditional enrollment may be allowed for up to 90 days if the parents/guardians submit a certificate from a physician or local health officer indicating that the child is in the process of receiving the required immunizations. This conditional enrollment includes vaccination series that cannot be completed within one medical visit. If the required vaccines can be completed in one medical visit, conditional enrollment DOES NOT apply. NRS 392.435

For students transferring from schools outside the State of Nevada, the provisions of NRS 392.430(5) apply.

Pursuant to NRS 392.437, students whose parent(s) or legal guardian(s) present a written statement that their child should not be immunized because religious belief prohibit such immunization shall be enrolled without a certificate of immunization.

Pursuant to NRS 392.439, students whose parent(s) or legal guardian(s) present a written statement signed by a licensed physician and the parent indicating a medical condition of the child precludes immunizations shall be enrolled without a certificate of immunization.

The exemptions authorized by NRS 392.437 and 392.439 shall be evidenced by a vaccine exception form (written statement). The school of enrollment will receive the vaccine exemption form and submit it to the Board of Trustees for approval.

REGULATION No. 504 – CONTINUED

Pursuant to NRS 392.446, in the event of a dangerous contagious disease determined by the State Board of Health or the local board of health, the Board of Trustees shall require that unimmunized children, including those exempted in NRS 392.437 and NRS 392.439, be immunized or remain outside the school environment.
